Prep Instructions for Flexible Sigmoidoscopy

You will need to purchase the following over-the-counter items:

- 2 Dulcolax Laxative Tablets
- 1 Fleets Enema

3 days before the procedure: Stop taking any blood thinning medications such as: Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Aleve, Plavix, Vioxx, Naproxen, Coumadin, and Heparin. Tylenol may be taken as needed for pain. Stop taking any anti-inflammatory medications and any iron or multi vitamins with iron. Talk to your prescribing doctor before stopping any medications.

<u>The afternoon before the procedure:</u> After lunch, you will be on a clear liquid diet for the rest of the day. Clear liquids include water, tea, clear juices, soda, & coffee without cream or milk, broth, or Jell-O without red or blue dye. You can stay on clear liquids until 4 hours before your checkin time.

At 5:00 PM: Take 2 Dulcolax laxative tablets

One hour before coming to the facility: Take the Fleets enema while laying on your left side.

PLEASE NOTE:

Bring your insurance card(s) & photo ID.

You will be sedated for this procedure. It is required to have someone drive you home. You should expect to be at the facility for approximately 2 hours. Your doctor will speak with you after the procedure. At that time you may want your driver present to help you recall the discussion due to being sedated.
